Family Advocacy Program

Served 26 at-risk families with the following services:

- ✦ 248 hours of case management services
- ✦ 158 hours of individualized parenting education
- ✦ 215 hours of life skills training
- ✦ 18 hours of individual counseling
- ✦ \$4175 in emergency financial aid



Agency Collaboration

- ✦ Collaborated with 43 local organizations
- ✦ Held 10 monthly meetings and published 10 monthly newsletters
- ✦ Organized Behavioral Health and Safe and Stable Family Strategy Teams
- ✦ Held second annual awards program and fundraiser
- ✦ Promoted WCFC at 19 countywide events



Mentor Program

- ✦ Increased volunteer mentors from 37 in August 2024 to 72 by May 2025
- ✦ Hosted our first Mentor Roundtable for mentor coordinators in region



Community Outreach

- ✦ Beginning in April 2025, distributed more than 30,000 pounds of food to 153 families.
- ✦ Assisted 550+ families with needed school supplies at annual Back to School Bash.



Holiday Assistance Programs

- White Christmas Program:
- ✦ 517 children from 231 families received Christmas gifts from community sponsors
- Shop with a Cop Program:
- ✦ 40 youth received gift cards and were paired with local officers, who assisted them in Christmas shopping for themselves and their families.



Warrior Connection

- ✦ Celebrated grand opening of student-based resource center in February 2025
- ✦ 185 families received help from food and toiletry pantry
- ✦ Hosted 8 meetings and/or trainings relating to strengthening families in White County
