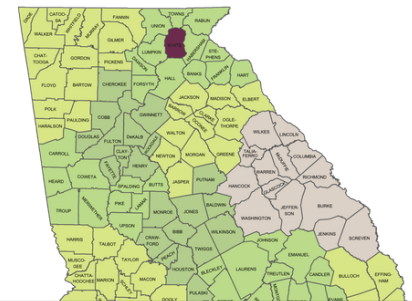

Family Advocacy Program

Supporting families with individualized guidance, education and resource connection.

- 🎯 Served an average of 54 families each month
- 🎯 Made 1,200+ connections to information, organizations and resources
- 🎯 Provided 435+ hours of parent education and life skills lessons
- 🎯 \$3845 in emergency financial aid



Agency Collaboration

- 🎯 Collaborated with 57 local organizations
- 🎯 Held 9 monthly meetings and published 10 monthly newsletters
- 🎯 Implemented Behavioral Health and Safe and Stable Family Strategies comprised of 22 agency representatives
- 🎯 Held third annual awards program and fundraiser with 100+ attendees
- 🎯 Promoted WCFC at 19 countywide events



Mentor Program

- 🎯 Matched 90 mentors with 95 students throughout all 7 public schools
- 🎯 1,394 total mentor hours for the school year
- 🎯 21 new mentors recruited, trained and background checked during school year



Food & Basic Needs Support

- 🎯 Distributed 1,300 food boxes via monthly food drive-thrus
- 🎯 Launched monthly free spaghetti supper through community partnership
- 🎯 Served 42 families during winter storms with no-cook food, jackets, showers and laundry services



Holiday Assistance Programs

White Christmas Program:

- 🎯 480 children from 216 families received Christmas gifts
- 🎯 74 community members and organizations sponsored families
- 🎯 107 volunteers spent 359 hours organizing and sorting gifts

Shop with a Cop Program:

- 🎯 40 youth matched with local officers to Christmas shop for themselves and their families



Family Learning & Support

- 🎯 Served 75 families at Warrior Connection with food, hygiene, clothing and laundry services
- 🎯 Piloted a hands-on healthy family cooking class called Cook & Connect
- 🎯 Launched Grand Connections, a kinship care support program for grandparents and relative caregivers
- 🎯 Hosted 151 attendees for CEU trainings for suicide prevention, behavioral threat assessment and ethics
- 🎯 Held four parent workshops on raising strong-willed children
